Wreaths and snowmen

Christmastime is lots of fun—we decorate the house, bake cookies, sing Christmas carols and maybe even sing in the church musical. The children at my church are singing "The Christmas Shop around the Corner" Sunday night and we are all looking forward to the program.

Christians can tell all their friends about Jesus during Christmas. Team Corsica works in France, and they make bread and cookies for their friends. They also decide on a special ornament and give them out with the baked goodies. Last year, they gave out ornaments that looked like wreaths. They explained to their friends that the love of Jesus is like the circle of the wreath. His love never ends.

This year they are giving ornaments that look like snowmen. Can you think of ways you can tell someone about Jesus with a snowman? Remember, Jesus wants to forgive us for our sins. When we tell Jesus about our sin and tell Him we are sorry, He will clean us as white as snow. He will clean us as clean as can be—just like we had never sinned. That's one way I can think of to tell my friends about Jesus. The Bible verse Psalm 51:7b says, "wash me, and I will be whiter than snow."

Will you pray for the team in Corsica, France? Pray for their friends who will get the snowmen ornaments plus bread and cookies. Can you do the same thing? Why not bake some cookies and decorate them to look like snowmen? Then put a few in a plastic bag and tie a note with Psalm 51:7b around the top of the bag. This Christmas, tell your friends how much Jesus loves them!
