When you drive around the town you live in, how many churches do you see? Is there "one on every corner" or several between where you live and your favorite shopping mall? Maybe there are even churches meeting in the shopping mall, the movie theater, or your school. Most of us are used to seeing our friends at church a couple of times a week. We pray together, sing together, and study the Bible together.

What if you lived in a place where you cannot find a church to go to on Sunday? Where the people worship many gods or a god who does not show love? Where you never hear the name of Jesus and you do not know who to ask about Jesus? Where there are no missionaries? What if? That's what it is like to be part of what we are calling a "forgotten people group."

Jesus hasn't forgotten them, and He wants all of them to hear the stories of the Bible. There are more than 3,000 people groups who have never heard about Jesus. More than 500 of those 3,000 have a population greater than 100,000. That's a lot of people!

What can you do to help? You can pray. Pray for God to send missionaries who will tell the stories of Jesus. Pray for the people to hear and ask Jesus to be their Savior.
