Many Lozi (LOH-zee) people live in Sesheke (she-SHAY-keh), Zambia. It's a dusty border town but it sits right on the Zambezi River. Fishermen crouch down in tiny dugout canoes on the banks of the river, trying to catch tiger fish in their nets. They look around all the time—they are watching out for crocodiles!

School girls and boys in their color-coordinated uniforms walk the sandy streets of Sesheke on the way to school. They pass the "Chicken Inn" and think about the greasy French fries and chewy chicken. People are everywhere—but it doesn't look like they have anything to do. They are just watching the time go by.

Three new Bible study groups started a few weeks ago. And twenty volunteers from Georgia went to Sesheke this last week to tell the Lozi people about Jesus. They learned how to tell the story of "Creation to Christ." Let's pray for the new Bible study groups and for all the new Christians. Pray that they will learn to love Jesus more every day.
