SUMMER CAMP

Have you studied the Soviet Union in school? Twenty years ago, everyone knew where to find the Soviet Union on the map. It was a country in Eastern Europe made up of several countries. Today, most of us know where Russia is—that was the biggest country in the former Soviet Union—and we might know about the Ukraine or Lithuania. But lots of people don't know much about the Central Asian countries that used to be a part of the Soviet Union like Tajikistan (pronounced TAH-jeek-is-stahn), Uzbekistan (ooz-BEHK-ees-stahn), or Kazakhstan (KAH-zahk-stahn).

This month workers will go to two schools in two Uzbek (OOZ-bek) villages to provide week-long summer camps for 50-plus children at each school. They have spent the school year making friends and helping to meet needs in the community. Now some volunteers who also came last summer will help with the summer camps.
