SING FOR JESUS

Over the phone (on speaker) she prayed and loudly sang songs for her great grandmother who has Alzheimers. Two Hindu ladies who had come for a visit heard it all. They were very touched by the faith of this little girl.

All of us can share the love of Jesus with our friends, our neighbors and our family. Please pray for AS to keep on singing and praying. Ask God to help her and her father as they plant churches where they live.
