



Me, start a PRAYERthreads group?

Interested in starting a PRAYERthreads group at church, in your community, on your campus, or wherever?

- Want to start a group? – start praying and ask God for direction and to lead you to some partners with the same heart.
- Don't know how to get started with prayer? Check out our download resources.
- Ask around and see if any of your friends are interested in praying for forgotten peoples. Two or three people together is a great start. Living rooms, garages, offices, dorm rooms or wherever you spend time will work for a meeting place.
- If you have a church group or campus event, ask for a spot to make an announcement and check out the interest.
- Prepare banners or posters
- If you've already chosen a people group, share info about your group whenever you can.
- Use email, Facebook, MySpace, Twitter, etc. to get word out about these forgotten people, and keep your prayer group connected.
